Directions for Use

NU-ARBOR Plant Wash Mixes readily with water and may be used in all types of sprayers. For best results apply full coverage spray on entire leaf surface. Use a large volume of solution to create a washing effect. Spray in the coolest and humid time of day.

PRODUCT CAN BE USED ON ALL PLANTS, TREES, COMMERCIAL FOOD CROPS WITH NO RESIDUE TOLERANCE.
ONE CAN USE NU-ARBOR Plant Wash TO THE DAY OF HARVEST.

Young ornamental use 1-400 dilution
Mature plants use 1-100 dilution
Fruit trees use 1-200 to 1-400 dilution
Berries & Vegetables use 1-100 to 1-200 dilution

Apply between dormancy and harvest. Use a higher rate of Plant Wash if it does not go into solution because of hard water. Can be mixed with fertilizers, fungicides as long as they are not acidic and a compatibility test has been done.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL DIRECTIONS

NU-ARBOR Plant Wash is stable-no special precautions needed. Disposal as with other natural soaps, no special disposal problems are present in this product. Dispose of in accordance with State and Local regulations.

KEEP OUT OF REACH OF CHILDREN

Keep container tightly closed when not in use. Never pour left-over material back into container. Avoid freezing in storage. Recommended storage limit is 18 months.

WARNING

NU-ARBOR Plant Wash being an alkaline product is not recommended for use on Delicate Ferns, Nasurtium, Sweet Pea, Violet, Mountain Ash, Japanese Maple, Horse Chestnut and other tender leaf plants as the soap can cause damage.

FIRST AID

Concentrated NU-ARBOR Plant Wash being an alkali can cause irritation of the eye and skin. Do not get it into eyes, wash thoroughly with fresh water and get medical attention. Ingestion: give victim several glasses of water and get medical attention.
